STIPULATIONS

1. Recipients must have completed coursework to achieve graduation requirements in the Biblical Studies Department at The Master's University (TMU).
2. Recipients must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.50 with a high level of standing in the area of biblical studies. Recipients are required to maintain a 3.7 cumulative GPA in order to continue to receive this scholarship. If the recipient drops below the 3.7 cumulative GPA requirement, he will receive one semester of probation. If during the probationary semester he does not attain the minimum GPA requirement, the scholarship will not be renewed in the following semester.
3. Recipients must be enrolled full-time at The Master's Seminary (TMS) at 11.0 or more credit hours for the following academic year. Recipients must complete the M.Div. program in 7 consecutive semesters.
4. Recipients must be preparing for a pastor-teacher ministry in the local church as evidenced by successful coursework in biblical studies (2 Timothy 3:16-17), active church involvement (Romans 12:1-8), and demonstration of spiritual gifting (Ephesians 4:11-13), and expressed desire to pursue the pastor-teacher ministry.
5. If the recipient drops below the full-time load at any point, he will be responsible for paying the difference in the part-time and full-time tuition rate.
6. Recipients are required to have finished their application to TMS for review purposes.
7. Recipients must attend the LA main campus.
8. This scholarship cannot be received in conjunction with any other TMS scholarship.
