



Seminary Completion Scholarship

Thanks to the generosity of friends of The Master's Seminary, the Seminary Completion Scholarship has been established to supplement the educational and/or living expenses of seminary students who are struggling to complete their seminary education due to financial difficulty.

Scholarship Amount:

- Amounts awarded may vary.
- Scholarship shall not exceed \$3500 per year.
- Winter and summer courses not included.
- Awards will be based on character, ministerial aptitude, academic performance, and affirmation by faculty and staff of TMS.

Minimum Requirements to Apply:*

- Must be enrolled full-time (11+ units) in the M.Div. or B.Th. program at the L.A. campus.
- Must have completed at least 30 units of coursework at The Master's Seminary.
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
- Must work a minimum of 29 hours per week.
- Have a desire for full-time pastoral ministry.
- Affirm the TMS Doctrinal Statement available at www.tms.edu.
