

2019 TMS Israel Trip—Tuition Scholarship Funds

TMS offers two courses that relate to the TMS Israel study trip:

- BI652 Geography of Israel course- 2 credits (spring semester)
- BI653 Field Studies in Israel course- 2 credits (in Israel)

1. For students taking BI652 in the spring semester:

The tuition rate charged will be in accordance with the normal tuition cost of the student's degree and enrollment status. *No Israel trip scholarship funds are available for the spring semester course.* Regardless, the course is highly valuable preparation for your time in Israel.

2. For students taking BI653 as part of the TMS Israel study trip:

The student will be charged tuition for that summer school course and a tuition scholarship will be placed into your student account before the end of the spring semester. This is an extra perk for going on the TMS Israel study trip. Everyone on the trip will take all the quizzes and exam and complete their reflection reports. For those taking the field studies course for credit, that course grade will become part of their academic transcript.

**** These scholarship funds are only for TMS students who are applying these credits to their TMS degree program.** Course credit can be applied to M.Div. or Th.M. programs.

How to apply for these scholarship funds: The students going on the Israel trip and taking BI653 will need to fill out a scholarship form (regardless of whether you receive an Israel trip scholarship [\$2500.00]) and submit it to Ryan Wethern in the TMU financial aid office or by email: rwethern@masters.edu.

2019 TMS Israel Trip—Direct Scholarship Funds

A donor who graciously supports Israeli students while they study at TMS has generously offered to assist TMS students to better understand their Bibles by helping them go on a study trip to Israel. The donor has provided some scholarship funds for our May/June 2019 TMS Israel study trip. **We will offer seven \$2,500 scholarships.**

Minimum requirements to receive a scholarship:

- Active/Current TMS student at Los Angeles campus
- 50 completed credit hours by the start of the Israel trip in the M.Div. program. If we have scholarship funds left after December 1, we will allow students with less than then 50 completed credit hours to submit a scholarship application for the \$2500.00 scholarship.
- GPA above 2.5
- Completion of the scholarship application

How do you apply for a scholarship?

1. Complete the TMS Israel trip scholarship application by December 1 and submit the application in person or by email to the TMU financial aid office—to Ryan Wethern: rwethern@masters.edu.
2. Turn in the trip registration form to the faculty secretary by December 1.
3. Pay the trip deposit (\$500.00) to the faculty secretary by December 1.
4. Scholarships will be awarded by December 15. If you are not awarded a scholarship and this makes it impossible to go on the 2018 TMS Israel study trip, TMS will refund the trip deposit.

Clarification:

**Students are not eligible to receive both the tuition scholarship (\$760) and the trip scholarship (\$2,500).

** Preference will be given to students who submit their applications and trip deposits earlier.

**These scholarship funds are only for TMS students and not for their wives, as great as it is for a wife to join her husband for a trip like this.

Scholarship Application Due Date: Friday, December 1, before 4 p.m. to the TMU financial aid office (to Ryan Wethern) or via email to rwethern@masters.edu.

*****This money will NOT be deposited into your student account. It will go into the TMS Israel trip budget and your trip cost will be reduced by \$2500.**
